
### Introduction

Lendlease is proud to present its Community Development Plan for the Brisbane Showgrounds precinct, an iconic urban regeneration project that aims to create a vibrant and sustainable community. This plan outlines our commitment to building a thriving and inclusive neighbourhood that will enhance the quality of life for residents, workers, students and visitors alike.



## **Project Background**

The Brisbane Showgrounds redevelopment by Lendlease is a significant urban regeneration project that aims to transform the historic Brisbane Showgrounds into a modern, mixed-use precinct. The project seeks to preserve the site's heritage while introducing residential, commercial, retail, and cultural spaces. The project has already seen the creation of The Green and The Yards residential apartments, Kingsgate commercial precinct and King Street which features a Rydges Hotel alongside an assortment of retailers.

- To support the creation of a vibrant and resilient community that authentically stitches into the fabric of the neighbouring area.

#### **Events and Initiatives**



#### King St Street Library

There is a community Street Library on King St. Filled with adult and children's books, its available for use for all community members within the precinct.



#### King St Book Club

Each monthly book club evening is held at a different King St venue, showcasing the variety of dining experiences that can be found throughout the precinct.



#### **Grants Program**

With a \$10,000 funding pool, we're here to support programs, initiatives or events that benefit the community and precinct of King St through improving social, environmental and economic outcomes. More specifically those which:

- Educate/upskill the community;
- Connect and strengthen relationships within the community;
- Assist the start up of community groups, programs, social enterprise;
- Celebrate the culture and history of the Brisbane Showgrounds area; and
- Activate public space (specifically Alexandria Park and the King St precinct).

This program has been running since 2021 and has helped bring to life a number of initiatives, including the Alexandria Park Jazz Music Concerts by the Jazz Music Institute, the Laneway Murals by Space & Co, and the 'Shop For Her' social enterprise fashion boutique by Suited to Success.

Brisbane Showgrounds hosts events for days and weeks of significance, aiming to improve community inclusion and wellbeing. These include National Reconciliation Week, NAIDOC Week, Wear it Purple Day, R U OK? Day and Lendlease Foundation Community Day.
