COMMUNITY GRANTS

The Lendlease Foundation Community Grants program is an initiative to aid not-for-profit organisations and charities that deliver impact within the community.

The Community Grants program is launched at the beginning of each year in partnership with Bendigo Bank Community Enterprise Foundation.

Ten grants of \$10,000 each are awarded to community organisations who have successfully met the eligibility criteria and progressed through the selection process.

Projects should address one or more of the following Lendlease Sustainability focus areas:

Economic prosperity
Community Inclusion
Wellbeing
Resources and Materials
Climate Action
Nature and Pollution

The selection criteria:

Includes, but are not limited, to:
Level to which the grant will be used for community programs/activities, rather than 'one-off' purchases of equipment/items.
What difference the grant will make to the organisation and the people/community it supports, with emphasis on the broad reach and longevity of the programs.

Selection process:

Applications are reviewed for eligibility by the Bendigo Bank Community Enterprise Foundation. Applications that meet the initial criteria will then be reviewed by the Lendlease Foundation Advisory Committee, consisting of Lendlease Foundation employees and other key Lendlease business stakeholders to create a short list. Shortlisted applications will then be listed for Lendlease employees to vote for the top 10 projects
