#### World Bee Day: Tuesday, 20 May


Raising awareness of the importance of protecting bees and other pollinators, the threats they face and their contribution to a sustainable future.

### King Street Precinct Unveils New Artwork by Dean Tyson

On February 17, we had the privilege of unveiling This Place Right Here (2024), a powerful artwork by Dean Tyson, a celebrated Goori artist from southeast Queensland. The piece now proudly resides at our head office, offering a reflective narrative that honours the history and significance of the land surrounding King Street.

The unveiling event allowed guests to hear firsthand from Dean about the piece's deeper meaning and its significance to the traditional owners. Using synthetic polymer paint on canvas, Dean's artwork explores the land's transformation from a peaceful hunting ground to the bustling city of Brisbane. It also acknowledges the beauty of the land prior to colonisation and the tragic history of the massacre of local Aboriginal families.



This Place Right Here is both a tribute to the past and a reminder of the land's ongoing importance to its First Nations people.

We are grateful to Dean Tyson for sharing his powerful vision with us, and we look forward to the lasting impact of his artwork, sparking reflection and conversation for years to come within our King Street community.
